1. Upgrade from Version 7.0 to 8.0, with 5,000 new titles – **\$185** (instead of **\$265**).
2. Upgrade from Version 6.0 to 8.0, with 9,800 new titles – **\$295** (instead of **\$415**).
3. Adding the 'Ahavat Shalom Publication' books – **\$155** (No discount available.)
4. 40 new Machon Yerushalayim titles and 140 new Chabad titles – free of charge for customers which have purchased this package in the past.
5. The Machon Yerushalayim package containing 360 titles, published as part of update 7.0, can still be purchased for only \$190.

**New features in update 8.0:**

1. **Hyperlinks:** This aid is based on state-of-the-art technology which enables researchers to locate references accurately and speedily. Thus, when a specific book includes a reference, such as Shas, the Rambam, or Shulchan Aruch, the program identifies it and flashes it on the page on which the reference appears.
2. **A program for deciphering books in Rashi script:** After selecting the passage, the user presses a key and the rashi script text is transformed into regular script.
3. **Use of Tabs (linguistic cards):** Always have your search results available! The results of any search you perform will be available in a convenient tab format for instant reference, whenever you want! Click on a result to browse that source.

**New titles in version 8.0:** The new version includes some **6,000 new Judaic titles**. They are divided in the following manner:

- a. The main software package contains 5,430 important books, such as *Tur Shirat Devora* (22 sections), *Talmud Bavli, Dikdukei Sofrim Hashalem* (12 volumes published by Yad Harav Herzog), *Piskei Harid and Piskei Hariaz* (15 volumes), all of the books of *Machon Moshe* (such as the 25-volume *Kapach* edition of *Mishne Torah*), a collection of 300 books from *Sifrei Yahadut Teiman*, and more. (This time we did not divide these books into three sections, since we saw that there was very little demand for such a format.)
- b. Part two includes 400 books of the *Ahavat Shalom* package, most of which are being published for the first time from manuscripts or precise editions of well-known and important books. The following partial list presents sample titles from each subject, which highlight the quality of the entire package. As you can see from the list, the *Ahavat Shalom* series deals with all subjects of Judaic studies.

**Rishonim:** *Halachot Pesukot laGeonim, Chidushei Harah* (2 volumes), *Shita Mekubetzet on Chulin* (2 volumes).

**Commentary on Shas:** *Shitat Mahariksh on Baba Kama* (2 volumes), *Chidushei Haram of Imran* (5 volumes).

**Commentary on Tanach:** *Lekach Tov, Shemen Hamor, Meir Tov* (14 volumes).
